## **Training and Education Policy**

Sea staff frequently attends external training for more specialized industry requirements or for the particular vessel types they will be serving on.

Comprehensive types of training such as the following may be performed, both ashore and on board company's managed vessels:

- Mandatory introduction, awareness and orientation training for all new employees and crew.
- Executive and management development training.
- Professional and technical development training.
- Clerical, communications and other skills training.
- Organizational development.

This way the Company tries to ensure that:

- Personnel assigned with the provision of services offered by the Company are appropriately experienced and trained in that task.
- Training needs are identified by means of ongoing appraisal of individual performance and development.
- Appropriate training for individuals is arranged in line with available resources and current operational demands.
- More experienced personnel in the company's business and operations shall be encouraged to share their knowledge with less experienced personnel.
- Adequate records of training and experience are maintained.
- National and international requirements for the manning of vessels are adhered to.
